### YOUTH HOMELESSNESS FUND (YHF)

The Youth Homelessness Fund is a local network of funders who are committed to reducing youth homelessness through leadership, education, advocacy, and collaborative grant making. In 2014, the Fund made a \$90,851 grant to administer the YouthCount 2.0, the first-ever comprehensive look into youth homelessness in the greater Houston area. In 2016, YHF granted \$65,000 to enhance collaboration of local nonprofit organizations serving homeless youth. Impact of the grant making by YHF is evident through immediate and tangible system changes.
