

# FAMILY GIVING CIRCLE & YOUTH LEADERSHIP TEAM

The Family Giving Circle is a year-long program designed for 7th-12th graders in Houston. This program is an opportunity for youth to engage in high-impact philanthropic efforts while building a solid foundation for a lifelong commitment to contributing to and understanding your community. Participants gain invaluable insight into the best practices of philanthropy as well as the opportunity to connect with peers and engage in meaningful philanthropic efforts. The program culminates with 12th graders, the Youth Leadership Team, leading the group and taking a deeper dive into different philanthropic tools and vehicles. Through the Family Giving Circle, young people have the power to amplify their generosity, develop their leadership skills, and undestand how to be engaged to create a positive impact in their community.

Greater Houston Community Foundation offers <u>donor advised funds</u> to philanthropic families across our region. Our fundholders are invited to participate in the Family Giving Circle as part of the services we provide to them.

Philanthropic families who would like to participate in the Family Giving Circle and Youth Leadership Team programs can speak with one of our philanthropic advisors about how to open a fund at the Foundation or contribute \$1,500 annually per family to the <u>Center for Family Philanthropy</u>. Annual contributors will be invited to participate in a selection of Center for Family Philanthropy programs including the Family Giving Circle, quarterly family volunteer opportunities for all ages, and our annual Family Philanthropy Day.
